
UNITY DAY!

ONLY CHILDREN MAY BE SERVED

The Summer Meals Programs are only to be served to children who are 18 years old or younger.

Meals may be served to young adults that are over 18 years old if they are mentally or physically disabled, and are enrolled in a school program for persons with disabilities. You must call NDS if you do serve this population.

ONLY SERVE DURING THE SERVE TIME

You cannot serve before or after these times. If you need to change your serve time, even for just one day, call NDS at least one (1) day before.

ONLY SERVE THE MEALS ON SITE

All summer meals should be served at your site unless you are on an approved field trip.

TAKE THE TEMPERATURE OF THE MILK!

As soon as the delivery person leaves, please take the temperature of the milk delivered.

Check the stem of the food thermometer for an indentation, or "dimple." Place your thermometer between two milk cartons at least as far as the dimple. Do not open a milk carton and put the thermometer inside of it. The milk may be received at 45 degrees but must be stored at 41 degrees or below.
